



- To integrate metacognitive activities, Differentiated Instruction, data analysis, and instruction in multiple literacies in grades K-12 in order to ensure equity and excellence for all students.
- To design and implement Performance Based Assessments in grades K-12 to ensure student engagement and varied data analysis to positively affect instruction .
